NH LAW 193-J (Formerly SB282) SUICIDE PREVENTION EDUCATION



THE PURPOSE OF THIS LAW IS TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF SUICIDES IN THE NH SCHOOL POPULATION BY ENSURING THAT SUICIDE PREVENTION EDUCATION AND TRAINING IS AVAILABLE TO SCHOOL PERSONNEL, STUDENTS AND THEIR PARENTS USING AGE-APPROPRIATE AND EVIDENCE-BASED MATERIALS.

EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT & CHARTERED PUBLIC SCHOOL SHALL DEVELOP A POLICY THAT INCLUDES THE FOLLOWING PROVISIONS:

- TRAINING FACULTY, STAFF, & SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS IN YOUTH SUICIDE RISK FACTORS, WARNING SIGNS, PROTECTIVE FACTORS, RESPONSE PROCEDURES, REFERRALS, POST-INTERVENTION & RESOURCES AVAILABLE WITHIN THE SCHOOL AND COMMUNITY.
- EDUCATING STUDENTS IN THE IMPORTANCE OF SAFE & HEALTHY CHOICES & COPING STRATEGIES, RECOGNIZING RISK FACTORS & WARNING SIGNS OF MENTAL DISORDERS & SUICIDE IN ONESELF & OTHERS, & PROVIDING HELP-SEEKING STRATEGIES INCLUDING HOW TO ENGAGE SCHOOL RESOURCES & REFER FRIENDS FOR HELP.
- > IDENTIFYING WITHIN THE SCHOOL THE PERSON OR PERSONS WHO SERVE AS THE POINT OF CONTACT WHEN A STUDENT IS BELIEVED TO BE AT AN ELEVATED RISK FOR SUICIDE.
- MAKING REFERRAL, CRISIS INTERVENTION, & OTHER RELATED INFORMATION, BOTH WITHIN THE SCHOOL & THE COMMUNITY, AVAILABLE FOR STUDENTS, PARENTS, FACULTY, STAFF & SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS.
- PROMOTING COOPERATIVE EFFORTS BETWEEN SCHOOL DISTRICTS, CHARTERED PUBLIC SCHOOLS, & COMMUNITY SUICIDE PREVENTION PROGRAM PERSONNEL.

TRAIN FACULTY, STAFF, & SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS

EDUCATE STUDENTS

IDENTIFY THE POINT OF CONTACT

CCF will work with the point of contact to ensure he or she is prepared for the role of "trusted adult" in the event that there is a student in crisis.

MAKE INFORMATION AVAILABLE

CCF provides concrete information on suicide prevention that staff, students and community members can apply to their daily life. This information is available in physical and online formats.

PROMOTE COOPERATIVE EFFORTS

CCF will continue to engage with schools and the community on scheduling annual trainings and on any pertinent suicide prevention education information or resources.
